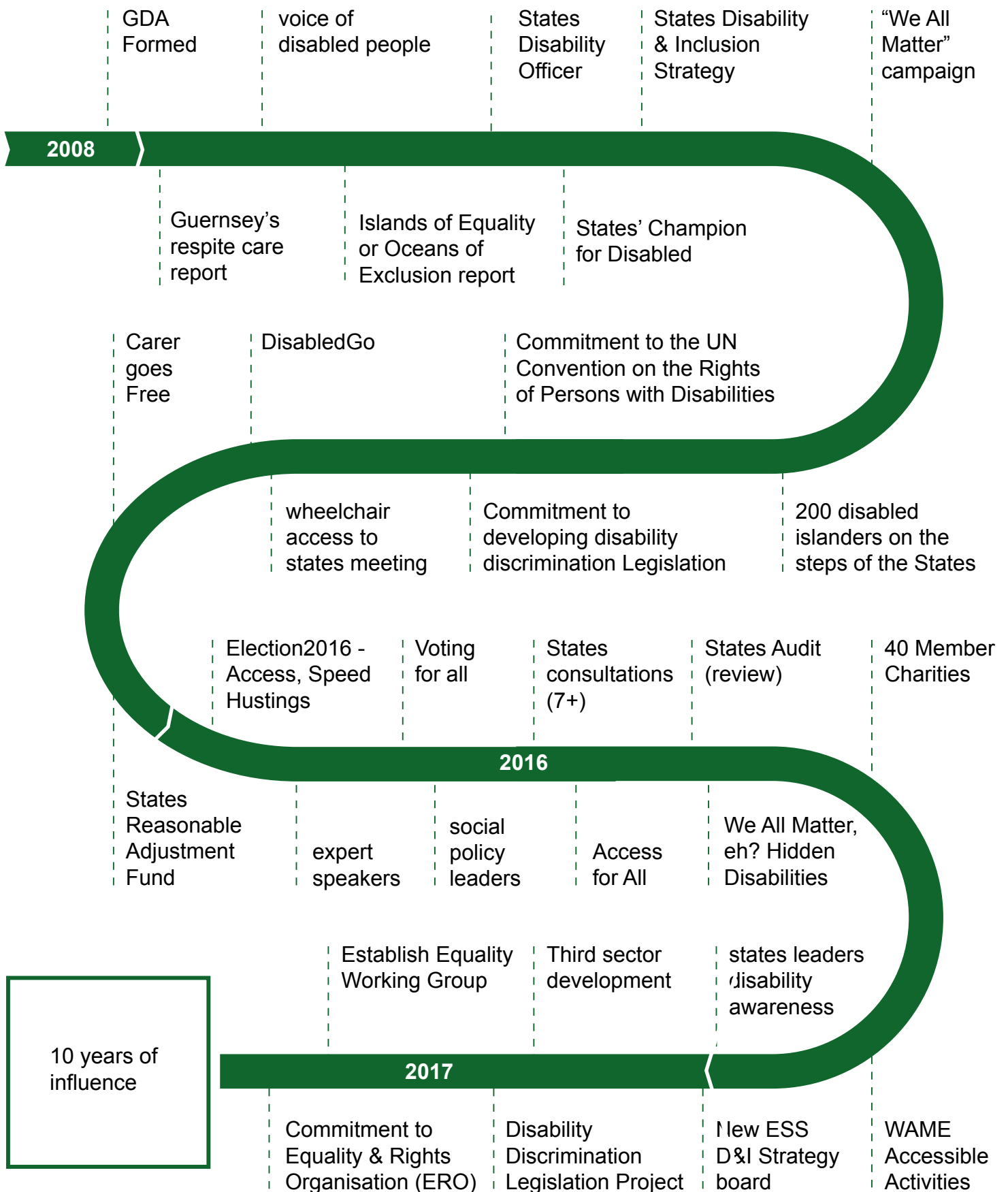


10 years of the GDA influencing Government policy



GDA member priorities (recorded for the last 4 years)

For the last four years we've been recording members priorities for living a full and inclusive life in Guernsey.

How is the Government (States of Guernsey), Third Sector (charitable groups) and community doing ?

- 1 Awareness and acceptance of the **RIGHTS** of disabled islanders
- 2 More disabled people in **EMPLOYMENT**
- 3 A person-centred **COMMUNITY CARE** and support system
- 4 **ACCESS** in all its forms (buildings, policies, customer services)
- 5 **RESPITE CARE** available according to need
- 6 A supportive **EDUCATION** system (33) and no 9 Pathways to **HIGHER EDUCATION**, training and lifelong learning (12) plus 1
- 7 **INFORMATION** about existing support services
- 8 Accessible, affordable **HOUSING**
- 10 Timely and comprehensive access to general **HEALTH SERVICES**
- 11 An adequate standard of living for those reliant on **BENEFITS**
- 11 A **TRANSPORT** system that is accessible for all
- 11 **SAFETY** from violence, exploitation and neglect

The GDA is an Equality Group: it is a member organisation working to achieve equality of opportunity for disabled people and carers in Guernsey by promoting rights, providing research and influence on Government policy, as a Collective Voice and empowering disabled people.
