
The GDA Executive Board

Rob Harnish is the manager of the Rob Short Centre & will work 1 day





Disability Discrimination Legislation Update by Ellen Pragnell, Senior Policy Officer

Towards the end of 2017, the ESS Committee sought bids from experts in discrimination law to advise the Committee on which country's legislation would be most appropriate for Guernsey to model its disability discrimination legislation. They appointed legal experts from the National University of Ireland Galway's Centre for Disability Law and Policy - Dr Shivaun Quinlivan and Dr Lucy-Ann Buckley. It is hoped that a model law will be identified by the end of March. Please read more here.
