10. Awards - Amount of Compensation

Compensation is a financial remedy awarded to someone who has been discriminated against. In considering the compensation, the Tribunal will look at the following heads of damage:

- 1. what the injured person has already lost, and what they might lose or need in the future, (compensation for financial loss) and
- 2. how much they have suffered (compensation for injury to feelings).

The following table shows the amounts of the awards proposed in the Prevention of Discrimination (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2022
